Definition

- 1) Agape is called out of one's heart by the preciousness of the object loved. It is a love of esteem, of evaluation. It has the idea of prizing. It is the most noble word for love in the Greek language.
- 2) Agape is not kindled by the merit or worth of its object, but it originates in its own God-given nature. God is love.
- 3) It delights in giving.
- 4) This love keeps on loving even when the loved one is unresponsive, unkind, unlovable, and unworthy. It is unconditional love.
- 5) Agape desires only the good of the one loved. It is a consuming passion for the well-being of others.
