Matthew

- 1:21 21 And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins.
- 1:23 23 *“Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel,”* which is translated, *“God with us.”*
- 7:21-23 21 *“Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. 22* Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ 23 And then I will declare to them, *‘I never knew you: depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’*
- 13:41-42 41 *The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness. 42* and will cast them into the *furnace of fire.* There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth.
- 26:27-28 27 Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, *“Drink from it, all of you. 28* For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.
- 28:19-20 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.

Mark

- 12:29-30 29 Jesus answered him, *“The first of all the commandments is: ‘Hear, O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is one. 30* And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.’ This is the first commandment.

Luke

- 13:23-28 23 Then one said to Him, *“Lord, are there few who are saved?”* And He said to them, 24 *“Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I say to you, will seek to enter and will not be able. 25* When once the Master of the house has risen up and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, ‘Lord, Lord, open for us,’ and He will answer and say to you, ‘I do not know you, where you are from,’ 26 then you will begin to say, ‘We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets.’ 27 But He will say, *‘I tell you I do not know you, where you are from. Depart from Me, all you workers of iniquity.’ 28* There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, and yourselves thrust out.
- 24:46-48 46 Then He said to them, *“Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day. 47* and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. 48 And you are witnesses of these things.

John

- 1:1-3 1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.
- 1:12-13 12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: 13 who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.
- 3:16 16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.
- 3:17 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.
- 3:36 36 He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him."
- 5:39-40 39 You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. 40 But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life.
- 6:35 35 And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst.
- 6:37 37 All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out.
- 6:38-40 38 For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. 39 This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. 40 And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day."
- 6:44 44 No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up at the last day.
- 6:47 47 Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has everlasting life.
- 10:9 9 I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.
- 10:28-29 28 And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.
- 11:25 25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.
- 14:6 6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
- 20:28-31 28 And Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"
29 Jesus said to him, "Thomas, because you have seen Me, you have believed. Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."
30 And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.

Acts

4:12 12 Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

Romans

3:21-26 21 But now the righteousness of God apart from the law is revealed, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, 22 even the righteousness of God, through faith in Jesus Christ, to all and on all who believe. For there is no difference; 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, 25 whom God set forth as a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed, 26 to demonstrate at the present time His righteousness, that He might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

10:8-13 8 But what does it say? “*The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart*” (that is, the word of faith which we preach): 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. 11 For the Scripture says, “*Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.*” 12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. 13 For “*whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.*”

Ephesians

1:7 7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

Colossians

1:13-14 13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, 14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

2:13 13 And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses.

2 Timothy

3:15 15 and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

Titus

2:13-14 13 looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, 14 who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

1 Peter

1:6-9 **6** In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials. **7** that the genuineness of your faith, *being* much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ. **8** whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see *Him*, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, **9** receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of your souls.

1 John

1:6-7 **6** If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie and do not **practice** the truth. **7** But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

2:23 **23** Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either: he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also.

5:11-12 **11** And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. **12** He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.

5:13 **13** These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may *continue* to believe in the name of the Son of God.

Revelation

1:8 **8** "I am the Alpha and the Omega, *the* Beginning and *the* End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."

1:18 **18** I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of **Hades** and of Death.

20:11-12 **11** Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. **12** And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is *the Book of Life*. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.

20:13-15 **13** The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and **Hades** delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. **14** Then Death and **Hades** were cast into the **lake of fire**. This is the second death. **15** And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the **lake of fire**.

21:5-6 **5** Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful." **6** And He said to me, "It is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, *the* Beginning and *the* End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts.

21:7-8 **7** He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. **8** But the cowardly, unbelieving, **abominable**, murderers, **sexually immoral**, **sorcerers**, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.
