## Jesus Math and Proof of the Messiah

Truth is when the word and deed become one. Prophecy is when a prophet of God says something will happen in the future. The prophecy is proven to be <u>truth</u> when it actually happens. All prophecies in Scripture are truth. Fulfillment of prophecy validates the Holy Bible and authenticates that Scripture is from God. All the prophecies of the Christ in the Old Testament became truth in Jesus Christ. Jesus fulfilled all the Messianic prophecies. Jesus is the Christ, the Messiah, the Son of God. The exact mathematics of Jesus fulfilling all the prophecies is astounding.

Let me explain:

There are only two possibilities logically regarding Jesus:

1) Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God. He is telling the truth and the words He says in Scripture is truth.

a) Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. *John 14:16* 

b) Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." *John 8:31-32* 

Or 2) Jesus is not the Christ, and not the Son of God. He is lying and the words He says are a lie.

These are the only two logical scenarios and both are mutually exclusive. What is the mathematics (mathematical odds) of scenario #1: Jesus is the Son of God. What is the mathematics (mathematical odds) of scenario #2: Jesus is not the Son of God. The mathematics is as follows:

The chance that Jesus fulfilled all the prophecies because <u>He is the Christ</u> and is <u>the Son of God</u> and <u>He is telling the truth</u>:

The chance that Jesus fulfilled all the prophecies by pure accident and randomness and He is not the Christ, not the Son of God and He is not telling the truth:

## And so on...

Mathematicians have studied the Fulfillment of the Messianic Prophecies in Jesus Christ.

The exact odds are as follows:

The chance that Jesus is lying is:

To visualize these odds I use two examples:

1) Imagine the planet Earth completely filled with dimes; the entire globe from the inside (center) to the surface. On only one dime is a black mark from a sharpie pen. All the other dimes are regular dimes with no marks.

What is your chance of picking a regular dime with no mark on your first try? –This is the chance Jesus is telling the truth.

What is your chance of picking the one dime with the black mark on your first try? – This is the chance Jesus is not telling the truth.

 Imagine <u>all</u> the stars in the universe. On one star only is placed a black mark by a sharpie pen. All the other stars are regular stars with no mark.

What is your chance of picking a regular star with no mark on your first try? –This is the chance Jesus is telling the truth and He is the Son of God.

What is your chance of picking the one star with the only black mark in the entire universe on your first try? –This is the chance Jesus is not telling the truth and He is not the Son of God.

This can be calculated mathematically. There are  $10^{66}$  stars in the universe. The chance of picking the one star with the black mark is  $1/10^{66} = 1$  out of  $10^{66} =$  These are the odds that Jesus is lying and is not the Son of God. In fact, the exact odds are even more small. They are  $1/10^{130}$ 

Your odds of picking a regular star with no mark on the first try are <u>extremely extremely extremely</u> great (likely). These are the odds that Jesus is the Son of God and what He says is the truth.

Are you willing to bet your soul for eternity on these odds? Your future in life depends on what choices you make. Your future for eternity depends on what choice you make regarding Jesus.

If you receive and accept Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior: You  $\rightarrow$  Heaven. If you refuse and reject Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior: You  $\rightarrow$  Hell.

Understand that the mathematical odds of the following five statements are <u>extremely</u>, <u>extremely</u>, <u>extremely</u> great (likely):

- 1) Jesus is the Christ—the Son of God
- 2) Jesus is the truth
- 3) The words of Jesus Christ in Scripture are truth. Jesus says Heaven is real and Hell is real.

And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell. *Matthew 10:28* 

4) Jesus is the <u>only</u> way to Heaven. You cannot get to heaven by believing in a false god and a false religion.

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. *John 14:6* 

You choose Jesus: You → Heaven.
You reject Jesus and choose another religion: You → Hell.

Do you realize that if you believe in another false god or false religion, your odds of going to Hell are extremely, extremely great. Do you realize that your odds of not going to Hell by believing in a false religion are  $1/10^{130}$  (1 out of  $10^{130}$ ).

If you are a nonbeliever, this is my advice to you: What if God is right and you are wrong? Are you creating your own God and belief system that has no evidence and no proof? Are you insane? Are you going to risk your soul for eternity? Are you going to risk going to Hell and the Lake of Fire on these mathematical odds? Hell and then Gehenna (Lake of Fire) are places of eternal torment, where you burn in fire forever, never sleep and there is no water and no companionship with God.

The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. *Revelation 20:10* 

This is the second death. And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire. *Revelation 20:14-15* 

The Son of Man will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness, and will cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth. *Matthew* 13:41-42

Do not be foolish with your soul. Go with the sure thing. Go with Jesus Christ – the only true living God.

## Proof that Jesus Christ is the Messiah and the Son of God

1) Jesus did signs, wonders and miracles that no one else in history has ever done.

"But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins"—then He said to the paralytic, "Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house." And he arose and departed to his house. *Matthew* 9:6-7

"Rise, take up your bed and walk." And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked. And that day was the Sabbath.

John 5:8-9

Since the world began it has been unheard of that anyone opened the eyes of one who was born blind. If this Man were not from God, He could do nothing."

They answered and said to him, "You were completely born in sins, and are you teaching us?" And they cast him out.

Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when He had found him, He said to him, "Do you believe in the Son of God?"

He answered and said, "Who is He, Lord, that I may believe in Him?" And Jesus said to him, "You have both seen Him and it is He who is talking with you."

Then he said, "Lord, I believe!" And he worshiped Him. John 9:32-38

If I do not do the works of My Father, do not believe Me; but if I do, though you do not believe Me, believe the works, that you may know and believe that the Father is in Me, and I in Him." John 10:37-38

The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. But you do not believe, because you are not of My sheep, as I said to you. John 10:25-26

2) The Resurrection of Jesus Christ and the people resurrected from the dead by Jesus Christ. Only the true living God has the power of Resurrection, the ability to raise someone from the dead. No false god has ever raised someone from the dead.

While He was still speaking, someone came from the ruler of the synagogue's house, saying to him, "Your daughter is dead. Do not trouble the Teacher."

But when Jesus heard it, He answered him, saying, "Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well." When He came into the house, He permitted no one to go in except Peter, James, and John, and the father and mother of the girl. Now all wept and mourned for her; but He said, "Do not weep; she is not dead, but sleeping." And they ridiculed Him, knowing that she was dead. But He put them all outside, took her by the hand and called, saying, "Little girl, arise." Then her spirit returned, and she arose immediately. And He commanded that she be given something to eat. *Luke 8:49-55*  Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." So he who was dead sat up and began to speak. And He presented him to his mother. Then fear came upon all, and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has risen up among us"; and, "God has visited His people." *Luke* 7:14-16

and they came, not for Jesus' sake only, but that they might also see Lazarus, whom He had raised from the dead. But the chief priests plotted to put Lazarus to death also, because on account of him many of the Jews went away and believed in Jesus. *John 12:9-10* 

Jesus raised Himself from the dead:

Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." *John 2:19* 

"Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father." *John 10:17-18* 

of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen, to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God. *Acts 1:1-3* 

3) The completely sinless life of Jesus Christ. He never committed one single sin in His entire life. No man can do this. Only God Himself can –God the Son.

For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him. *2 Corinthians 5:21* 

4) The mathematical proof of Jesus fulfilling in the New Testament all the prophecies of the Christ from the Old Testament.

Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures. Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day" *Luke 24:44-46* 

But you do not have His word abiding in you, because whom He sent, Him you do not believe. You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life. *John 5:38-40*  Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?" And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself. *Luke* 24:25-27
